

A regular meeting of the City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street on Monday, February 26, 2007, at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Davidson called the meeting to order. Present were Mayor Davidson and Councilpersons Letarte, Brown, Norris and Greenhoe. None were absent.

The invocation was given by Pastor Thomas Evans of the First United Methodist Church.

The Agenda was approved as printed.

The minutes from the February 12, 2007, regular meeting and the February 20, 2007, worksession minutes were approved as printed.

Councilwoman Brown moved that disbursements of \$718,007.71 be approved; seconded by Councilwoman Letarte, passed unanimously.

Pastor Scott Boles of the First Baptist Church of Eaton Rapids gave a presentation on the Eaton Rapids Alliance for Substance Abuse Elimination (ERASE).

Mayor Davidson read Council's Proclamation in Support of the ERASE Program and presented the Proclamation to Pastor Boles.

City Manager LeFevere read for First Reading Ordinance 2007-1, an Ordinance to Amend the Code of the City of Eaton Rapids by Amending Chapter 11, Garbage and Trash, Article II, Private Collections, Adding Section 43, Collection Times. This was for First Reading Only, No Council Action is Required.

Councilwoman Brown moved Council Approve to Amend the 2007 Budget by increasing revenue line item 265-301-69400 from \$0.00 to \$200.00 and increasing expenditure line item 265-301-76000 from \$0.00 to \$200.00; seconded by Councilman Greenhoe, passed unanimously.

Councilman Norris moved Council approve the Resolution for the Eaton Rapids Soccer Association to be recognized as a nonprofit organization operating in the City for the purpose of obtaining a charitable gaming license; seconded by Councilwoman Letarte, passed unanimously.

Sonja Seaks, 219 S. Main Street, appeared before Council regarding the snow removal ordinance.

Councilwoman Brown reported on the following: invited the public to the next ERASE meeting.

Councilman Greenhoe reported on the following: thanked Pastor Boles for his presentation; thanked Mrs. Seaks for her concerns.

Councilwoman Letarte reported on the following: congratulated the Eaton Rapids High School Swim Team on their recent accomplishments.

Police Chief Malewski reported on the following: that the Department did a canine sweep at the schools on the 22nd.

Fire Chief McNutt reported on the following: that the station will be hosting a Fire Officer Safety Program.
