

A regular meeting of the City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street on Monday, March 26, 2007, at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Davidson called the meeting to order. Present were Mayor Davidson and Councilpersons Letarte, Brown, Norris and Greenhoe. None were absent.

The invocation was given by Councilwoman Brown.

The Agenda was approved as printed.

The minutes from the March 12, 2007, regular meeting and the March 20, 2007, worksession minutes were approved as printed.

Councilwoman Letarte moved that disbursements of \$1,105,432.47 be approved; seconded by Councilman Greenhoe, passed unanimously.

City Clerk Reinecke introduced for First Reading Ordinance 2007-2, an Ordinance to Amend the Code of the City of Eaton Rapids by Amending Chapter 8 ½, Electric Service, Article V, Rates, Section 84, Shut Off for Nonpayment. This was for First Reading only, no Council action was required.

Councilwoman Brown reported on the following: That warmer weather is here and urged everyone to drive carefully; and that if students needed a listening ear for something that was going on in their lives to find someone to listen and help them through whatever they were going through.

Police Chief Malewski reported on the following: that a tree has been planted at the Public Safety Facility in honor of Sergeant Verhougstraete's Father; that his wife will be traveling to Washington D.C. to present the White House Easter Egg to First Lady Laura Bush.

Mayor Davidson reminded everyone that the next Worksession will be on April 9th at 5:00 p.m., and that Council will be trying this time before the Regular Council Meetings to see if this will work for everyone. He also stated that at the next Worksession the Goals and Objectives will be reviewed.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:09 p.m.
